

Content Hosting Guide

For Dropbox

This guide will walk you through hosting and sharing a Soggy Beans Current using Dropbox.

Dropbox allows you to upload your Current as a ZIP file and create a shared link that can be used by other players.

Once set up, you can use this shared link as the URL for your Current.

What You'll Need

1. A Dropbox account
 2. A Soggy Beans Current exported as a ZIP file
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Host Your Current

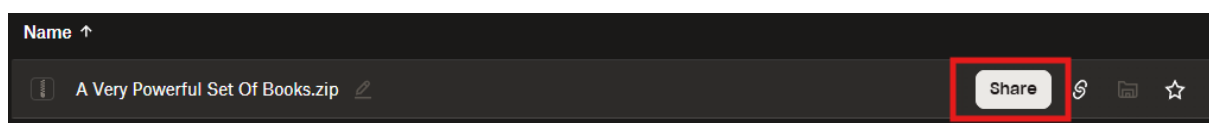
1. Upload Your Current

Open Dropbox and upload the ZIP file for the Current you want to host.

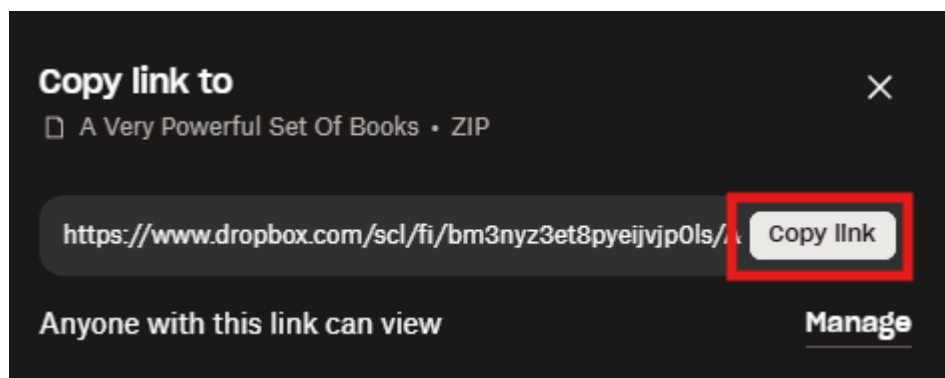
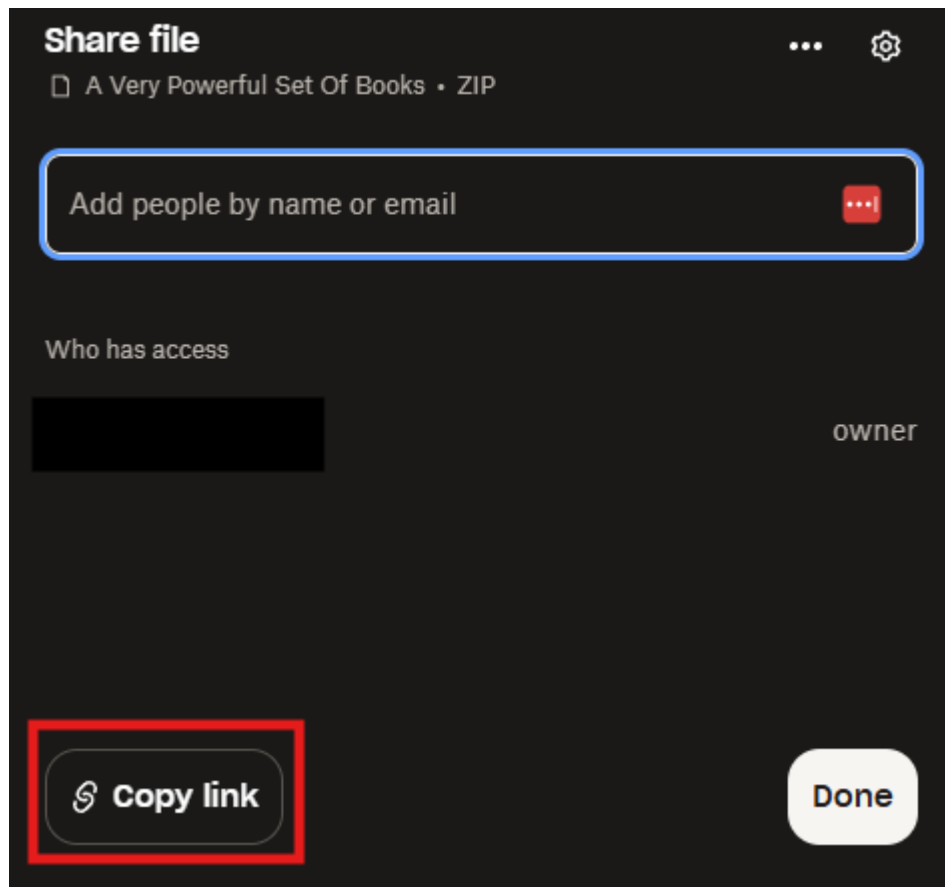
Once uploaded, locate the file in Dropbox.

2. Create a Shared Link

Hover over your uploaded Current and click **Share**.



Click **Copy link**.



This allows anyone with the link to access the Current.

3. Make the Link Download the Current

By default, a Dropbox shared link may open the file on Dropbox instead of downloading it directly.

At the end of the copied URL, change:

`dl=0`

to:

`dl=1`

For example:

`https://www.dropbox.com/sc1/fi/.../current.zip?rlkey=...&dl=0`

becomes:

`https://www.dropbox.com/sc1/fi/.../current.zip?rlkey=...&dl=1`

Use this updated URL as the URL for your Current.

Update Your Current

When updating a Current hosted on Dropbox, replace the existing file rather than deleting it and uploading a new one.

This keeps the existing shared link associated with the Current.

1. Replace the Existing File

Upload the updated Current ZIP to the same location in Dropbox using the same filename as the existing Current.

Dropbox will update the existing file rather than creating a separate copy.

Do not delete the original file first.

2. Keep Using the Existing URL

Because you replaced the existing file rather than creating a new one, the existing shared URL will continue to work.

Anyone already subscribed to the Current can keep using the same link.

Important

Always **replace the existing Current file** when uploading an update.

Do not delete the existing Current and upload it again as a new file, as this can generate a different shared link and break the URL being used by existing subscribers.

Keep using the same shared URL for the Current, including the **d1=1** change.
